#### SUMMARY

An estimated 413,000 acres of wheat were planted for 2017, down 21 percent from 2015. Low plantings continue to be attributed to weaker wheat prices and increased competition from other crops. The growing season has generally been characterized by a wet crop year. Some dryland wheat in the Sacramento Valley was reported as lost *after* planting, mainly due to flooded fields. Acreage planted to Red and White wheat varieties decreased 13 percent from the 2015 season. Durum wheat decreased 59 percent in plantings.

### **RED AND WHITE WHEAT**

Hard Red wheat, the top wheat class grown in California, accounted for 74 percent of all acreage grown in California this year. WB Patron (25.3 percent) was the top planted red wheat variety, followed closely by SY-Summit 515 (13.9 percent). Yecora Rojo remained the most commonly planted red variety in the Southern part of California, and WB 9668 in the Sierra and Northern part of California. Patwin 515 was the top Hard White wheat planted and Yamhill, New Dirkwin, and Alpowa topped the Soft White varieties. Approximately 65 percent of all red and white varieties are grown in the San Joaquin Valley.

### DURUM

Durum acreage in California decreased by 59 percent from 2015 planted acreage. Orita accounts for 17.1 percent of the 2017 durum wheat planted acreage in California, making the 10<sup>th</sup> consecutive year as the most popular durum wheat variety. Desert King and Tiburon rank second and third, respectively, with 12.2 and 8.5 percent of durum wheat varieties planted in in Southern California. Volante, top planted variety in the San Joaquin Valley, accounts for 12.2 percent of the 2017 durum wheat planted acreage in California.

#### **Survey Description**

This report reflects wheat that was planted in the Fall of 2016/early Winter 2017 for harvest in Spring/Summer of 2017; as well as intended Spring plantings in far Northern California. This survey estimates the state's *planted* acreage.
